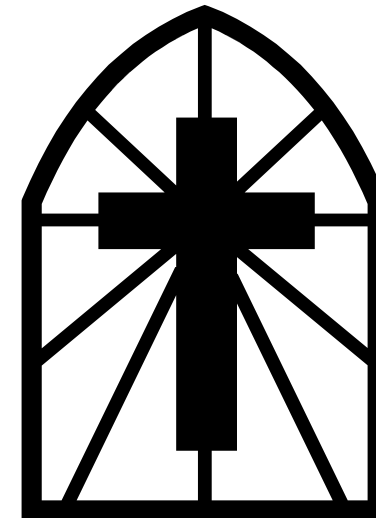

Psalm 111 - To Be Wise

'The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and of good understanding are those that keep his commandments: his praise shall endure for ever.'

Psalm 111:10 (APBA)
